The purpose of providing scholarships is to provide financial assistance for educational opportunities to individuals with commitments to rural communities, to support those wishing to pursue advanced training in career preparation, and to encourage emphasis for careers in telecommunications or any other field which would enhance rural development in the Uintah Basin.

Charles Crozier Memorial Scholarship for Nontraditional Students

This scholarship was established in 1995 as a memorial scholarship honoring Mr. Charles Crozier, a former president, director, and employee of Uintah Basin Telephone. This scholarship will be accepted at local institutions only.

The Charles Crozier Memorial Scholarship is restricted to students who have not attended high school for at least one year, and who are STRATA Networks members or dependents of members enrolling at higher education institutions located in the Uintah Basin, such as UBTECH and USU.

Two nonrenewable scholarships of up to \$2,500 per year will be awarded. Scholarships are to be paid in equal installments based on whether the education is on a quarter, semester, or program basis. Each installment is awarded based on the prior quarter, semester, or program being successfully completed.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be a current STRATA Networks member.
 - Dependents must have a GPA of 2.35 or higher.
 - A person may only receive or have one scholarship from the company in a year.

Essay

A one-page minimum essay which includes the following topics:

1. A brief description of your higher education and future career plans.
2. An explanation of how your field of study will contribute to the telecommunications industry and enhance rural development over the next 10 years.
