- Official high school transcript for GPA, ACT, & Class Rank verification.
- Two letters of recommendation from an educator or advisor, a parent or guardian, or your employer (if applicable).
- List of other scholarships/grants or financial aid received.
- A one-page minimum essay briefly stating a specific example or time in your life where technology and/or STRATA's products or services have had a major positive impact.
- Recent high-resolution photo of the applicant (*not a photocopy*).

Applicants must be immediate family members of a current STRATA Networks member. ("Family members" are sons, daughters and stepchildren, including those under legal guardianship or an adopted status.)

Incomplete applications will not be considered for awards. If you are selected, you may be asked to participate in an interview and to provide a high-resolution photo for promotional materials.

The purpose of STRATA Networks' scholarships is to provide financial assistance for educational opportunities to individuals with commitments to rural communities, to support those wishing to pursue advanced training in career preparation, and to encourage emphasis for careers in telecommunications or any other field which would enhance rural development in the Uintah Basin.

Richard Adams High School Senior Renewable Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2012 as a memorial scholarship to honor Mr. Richard Adams, a past STRATA Networks employee, who lost his life while doing maintenance work during regular working hours. This scholarship (one per year) is available to graduating high school students who are dependents of STRATA NETWORKS members. The scholarship is to be used for post high school education such as colleges, universities, technology centers, or other advanced training centers or programs. This scholarship is payable up to \$10,000 in four equal installments of \$2,500 per school year, based on meeting eligibility requirements each school year. Preference will be given to those who meet the following criteria and are selected by the Scholarship Committee.

- Study communications, technology, or business-related fields.
- Future plans include returning to the local community.
- Meet requirements of the STRATA Networks' Board Scholarship Committee to prequalify for the next year's scholarship renewal.

STRATA Networks' High School Senior Scholarships

These scholarships (ten per year) are available for dependents of STRATA Networks members who are graduating from high school. The scholarship is to be used for post high school education such as colleges, universities, technology centers, or other advanced training centers or programs. These are nonrenewable, up to \$2,500 per academic year.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be immediate family members of a current STRATA Networks member (STRATA Networks membership requires broadband or landline service. "Family members" are sons, daughters and stepchildren, including legal guardianship or an adopted status.).
- Dependents must have a GPA of 2.35 or higher.
- A person may only receive or have one scholarship from the company in a year.
- Recipients should attend STRATA Networks' Annual Meeting held (COVID-allowing) on June 10, 2021. If circumstances will not allow attendance, recipients must contact Cindie Gilbert at 435-622-5265.
